

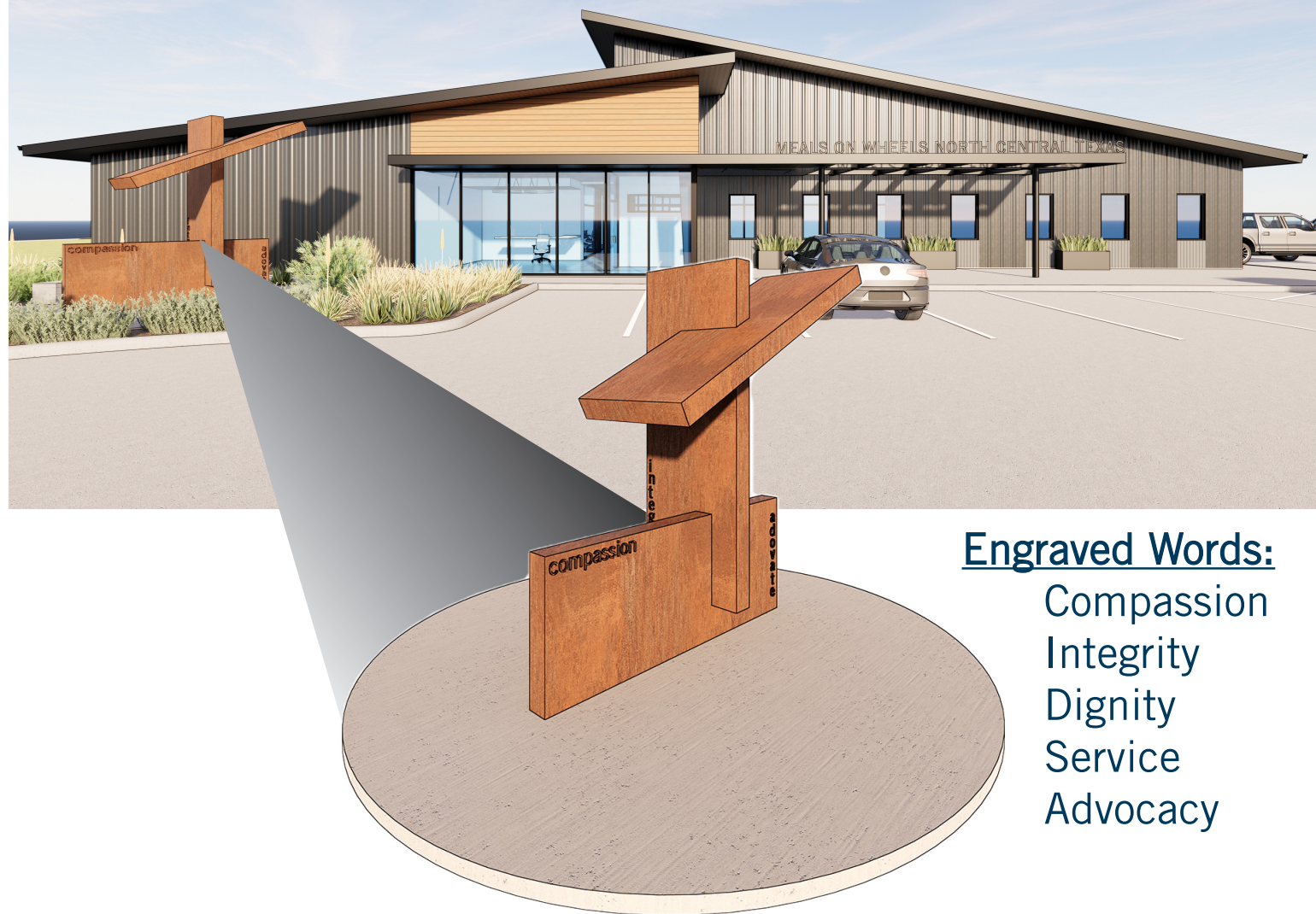

BIG THINGS HAPPENING AT OUR
DISTRIBUTION FACILITY



Each day, our army of staff and volunteers mobilize across 2,772 square miles distributing more than 1,000 meals per day to seniors in Johnson, Ellis, & Navarro counties. With our new mural, we invite volunteers, seniors, and the community to stop, enjoy the art, and take a picture. We are also installing a new 40'x40' freezer, providing space for current needs, while allowing room to grow.

WHY

The goal of this Capital Campaign is to provide the space needed for Meals on Wheels North Central Texas to continue to grow and serve all who need our assistance. 46 years old, the organization has outgrown its current space. Expanding from one to three counties in just the last 2 decades; we are left with no more room to grow. Personnel currently share office space, hindering privacy needs for conversations with seniors, donors, family members, and caregivers.

The new 7,715 square-foot space would provide additional office space for existing and much needed new personnel, as well as a multipurpose room for volunteer and group trainings, donor receptions, workspace for groups to gather and assemble care packages, and more.

The additional storage space provided would also give MOWNCT the ability to gather senior related items, creating a senior pantry filled with toiletries, incontinence care items, cleaning products, and other basic necessities. It will also provide the necessary storage space for our AniMeals program and other MOWNCT related items.

Lastly, MOWNCT plans to install a large 40X40 square-foot freezer at our distribution facility, allowing space for all meals needed to serve Johnson, Ellis, and Navarro counties, while leaving room to grow.
